

# ANISHINAABEMOWIN EARLY CHILDHOOD

**CREDENTIAL:** Ontario College Diploma

**PROGRAM LENGTH:** 2.5 years (5 semesters) (September 2020 – April 2022)

**START DATE:** September 2020 (Full-time status)

**DELIVERY MODE:** Intensive Delivery Mode; Students attend business-week module sessions, and some weekend sessions (Friday evening-Sunday afternoon) approximately once per month.

## PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Anishinaabemowin Early Childhood (AEC) program is designed to help bridge generational gaps and build in-service learning opportunities within Aboriginal communities. Access to education in early childhood aids in the healthy development of children, intellectually and socially. This highly specialized Anishinaabe immersion program, designed to prepare proficient Ojibwe language speakers as early childhood educators, will assist students to design and deliver meaningful, quality early childhood education programs and services targeted to early childhood development that builds on their cultural strengths.

The AEC program incorporates all aspects of Anishinaabe'aadziwin (Anishinaabe worldview) extensively throughout the whole program. Anishinaabe'aadziwin is necessary to accommodate learning styles and receptiveness of First Nations communities whom are mainly kinesthetic, tactile, visual and auditory learners. The method of instruction in this program is a combination of Anishinaabemowin and English.
