To our valued students, partners and community service providers:

Kenjgewin Teg is committed to ensuring a safe and healthy place of learning for our students, staff, community members and service providers. We are also committed to responding to the ever-changing environment and progressive, protective measures during the COVID-19 pandemic as deemed by the World Health Organization. In supporting the call to assist in slowing the spread of the virus, Kenjgewin Teg has decided to enact the following measures for staff and students:

- All Pathways and Mshiigaade Miikan programming will continue to be suspended until April 6, 2020. Learning Coaches are available to assist students that are interested and have the necessary resources to continue working through the eLearning platform from March 23 – April 5, 2020.
- The Trades Fundamentals and Welder Fitter programs will be suspended until April 6, 2020.
- Business Administration and Computer Applications will be delivered through online delivery beginning March 23, 2020; Instructors will be in contact with the students regarding course/assignment delivery mechanisms.
- The Personal Support Worker program (placements) will continue as is and will be monitored daily and weekly through completion – any changes required will be assessed and determined as/if needed.
- Students that are interested in continuing to do course work, continue assignments and communicating with Instructors are welcome to sign out a laptop for these reasons. An employee will be available on-site on Monday, March 23, 2020 from 10:00 – 2:00 p.m. Alternate dates and times are open for pick up but by appointment only. - The Kenjgewin Teg office as well as the Anishinabek Skills, Innovation and Research Centre will continue to be closed until April 6, 2020. Although staff will be working from home, we continue to remain accessible during business hours. Please feel free to contact staff via email or by phone.
- All meetings and events previously planned and hosted by Kenjgewin Teg will be cancelled indefinitely.
