- A commitment to actively participate in scheduled quarterly meetings; and
- A Team player.

Term of Appointment:

The appointment is for a two-year period.

Time of Commitment:

The Board of Directors meet a minimum of four (4) times per year, with additional Special Meetings as/if required.
