In this module, participants will begin with an acknowledgment of the beautiful local territory through ceremony, affirming the Anishinaabe cultural history and providing an overview of colonial history with specific impacts within Indigenous people's communities and families. The module begins to establish the context of contact and colonization and introduces cultural learning protocols, land protocols, and Indigegogy. Setting the foundation for understanding decolonization and Indigenization in our spirits, hearts, minds, and practices, participants will begin to transform their whole selves while restoring a clear sense of knowing.

- Experience Indigenous protocols.
- Be introduced to elements of cultural teachings in circle.
- Explore and examine an overview of colonial history.
- Have an experiential learning experience.
