CREDENTIAL: Certificate of Participation or Program Certificate

PROGRAM LENGTH: Individuals can register for modules of their preference or complete the entire program (minimum six of the eight two-day sessions over two years).

DELIVERY: Virtual (via Zoom)

The Decolonizing Education Certificate is designed for individuals who want to develop their capacity to understand Indigenous perspectives in the history of colonization to contemporary realities in Canada and are interested in responding to the Truth and Reconciliation Commission (TRC) calls for action in a meaningful way.
