

SPRING AQ COURSE OFFERING

OUTDOOR EXPERIENTIAL EDUCATION

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION: Kenjgewin Teg is an approved provider of Additional Qualifications (AQ) courses, which are professional learning opportunities for educators registered with the Ontario College of Teachers (OCT).

CREDENTIAL: Additional Qualification (AQ) Outdoor Experiential Education, Schedule C

INSTRUCTOR: Sarah Earley, OCT

DATES: April 2 - May 31, 2025

COURSE LENGTH: 125 hours - 9-week online, independent, and self-paced course. Online groups will be established for those wanting to engage in collaborative group work.

LOCATION: Online remote delivery with synchronous and asynchronous learning.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:
The knowledge acquired in this course, both theory and practice, enables candidates to critically explore, reflect, and dialogue in a variety of experiential learning activities in outdoor settings, including natural, built, and cultural. Experiential learning is at the heart of Anishinabek knowledge; the candidate experiments with planning and designing activities, assignments, and research to help nurture their own pedagogies. Additionally, including local knowledge holders and Elders provides real-life learning opportunities, virtually or in person. This practice creates a model that candidates can add to their teaching bundles and take to their classrooms.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Teachers certified with the OCT are eligible to take AQ courses. Ontario B.Ed students may take courses prior to membership with OCT if they have met all the requirements to graduate and if they have applied to the OCT for a Certificate of Qualification.

COURSE FEE: \$ 675.00

Payment Options: Credit Card (Visa, Mastercard), e-Transfer, purchase order, or certified cheque.
