## TEACHER LEADERSHIP PART 1

**PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:** Kenjgewin Teg is an approved provider of Additional Qualifications (AQ) courses, which are professional learning opportunities for educators registered with the Ontario College of Teachers (OCT).

**CREDENTIAL:** Additional Qualification (AQ) Teacher Leadership Part 1

**COURSE LENGTH & MODE OF DELIVERY:** 125 hours, with every Tuesday mandatory synchronous classes via MS Teams and the remaining balance as asynchronous learning.

**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** The focus of the Additional Qualification – Teacher Leadership Part I course is to explore and enhance: i) professional practices, ii) critical pedagogies, and iii) knowledge and skills. This course is open to all teacher candidates with an interest in further developing their skills as an effective teacher, with a desire to implement an approach reflective of Anishinaabeg pedagogy that is combined with Euro-Western philosophies of teaching and learning. The intent of this course is to support the development and enhancement of the candidate's skills in teacher leadership. The course is built on the framework of inquiry-based learning that supports holistic and integrated learning. Professional judgment, knowledge, and practices support the critical pedagogy of this AQ course.

**ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:**

Teachers certified with the OCT are eligible to take AQ courses. If you have successfully completed your professional education program, you may take AQ courses through a faculty of education.
